Horse Show Rules:

1. The horse show committee, nor Dusty Dog Horse Farm will not be responsible for any damages, injury or loss of persons, horse/pony or property of exhibitor or spectator incurred on or off the horse show grounds
2. Show attire required
3. Stabling is available for an additional cost please contact show manager for availability
4. Dogs must be leashed at all times
5. Certified Helmet must be worn at all times while mounted
6. Pre - Entries close the Saturday before each show
7. Returned checks are subject to a \$30 fee
8. Classes may be cancelled, split or combined as entries warrant
9. EMT will be on show grounds
10. There will be a farrier available on the show grounds
11. Please be respectful of the show grounds and clean up after yourselves and your horses,
12. Riders will not be required to wear a mask. All other spectators, trainers, and riders while not mounted will be required to wear a mask.
13. Hand Sanitizer will be available on show grounds
14. CoCo Classic prize can be put towards entry fee.

Class Descriptions

6 Ribbons to be awarded in each class

Junior/Adult Division – Open to junior and amateur adult riders. Fences not to exceed 3'. NEHC “C” Rated

NH Junior Medal – fences not to exceed 3'. Junior riders 18 years of age and younger must accumulate 12 points in order to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change in direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1 – 18. NEHC “C” Rated

NEHC Junior Medal - Open to junior members of the New England Horseman’s Council who have not reached their 18th birthday. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences set at a eight from 3’ to 3’3” with a combination and two changes of direction after the first obstacle. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge’s discretion. To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course. NEHC “C” Rated

NH Adult Medal - fences not to exceed 2’9. Amateur riders 18 years of age and older must accumulate 12 points in order to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change in direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1 – 18. NEHC “C” Rated

NEHC Adult Medal – Open to adult amateur members of the New England Horseman’s Council. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences set at a eight from 2’9 to 3’ with a combination and two changes of direction after the first obstacle. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge’s discretion. To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course. NEHC “C” Rated

Children/Adult – Open riders of all ages who have not competed over the height of 2’9”. Fences will not exceed 2’6. NEHC “C” Rated

NH Children Medal - fence heights not to exceed 2’6” horses/large ponies; 2’ small/medium ponies. Open to junior riders who have never shown higher than 3’ at any recognized show. Children’s riders must accumulate 12 points in order to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. NH Children’s Medal, NH Modified Adult Medal, and/or NH Modified Children’s Medal may be combined if there are not enough

entries to fill them separately. To be shown at respective height. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-8. Note: If a rider wins Children's medal class at year-end finals two (2) years consecutively, the rider is no longer eligible to compete in class again at finals. NEHC "C" Rated

Modified Children/Adult – Open to riders of all ages who have not competed over the height of 2'6". Fences will not exceed 2'3". NEHC "C" Rated

NH Modified Children Medal - fence heights not to exceed 2'3". Open to junior riders who have never shown higher than 2'6" at a recognized show. Must accumulate 12 points to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 6 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-7. Note: When rider wins Modified Children's medal class at year-end finals two (2) years consecutively, the rider is no longer eligible to compete in class again at finals. NEHC "C" Rated

NH Modified Adult Medal - fence heights 2'3"-2'6". Open to amateur riders 18 years of age and older who haven't shown higher than 2'6" at a recognized show in the current or previous 3 years. Must accumulate 12 points to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-7. Note: When rider wins Modified Adult medal class at year-end finals, he/she must skip one (1) year of competing in the class at the finals but may return to compete in the class the following year. NEHC "C" Rated

Lead Line – Open to riders of any age who are not comfortable riding off the line. Riders will perform on a lead line at the walk and trot with diagonals not to count.

Walk Trot – Open to beginning riders of any age and/or green horses/ponies. To be shown at the walk trot.

Hunter Pleasure – open to all horses of a hunter type ordinarily used for pleasure purposes with no limitations to status of rider. Light contact with horse's mouth is required. To be judged on performance, manners, quality, presence, suitability, substance and soundness. Open to horses only.

NEHC Pleasure - open to NEHC members and non-members. Open to all horses ordinarily used for pleasure purposes with no limitations as to the status of rider or place of residence. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Will be required to back. Loose rein on command of judge only, but without loss of contact. Shall be judged on manners, performance and quality in that order. *non pointed NHHJA

Short Stirrup – Open to riders 12 years of age and under. Riders cannot have shown higher than 18”.

Long Stirrup – Open to riders over the age of 13 years of age. Riders cannot have shown higher than 18”.

NH Novice Medal - fence heights not to exceed 18”. Open to junior and amateur adult riders who have never shown higher than 2’ at a recognized show. Must accumulate 12 points to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 6 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. Note: When rider wins Novice medal class at year-end finals 2 years consecutively, he/she is no longer eligible to compete in the class again at finals. NEHC “C” Rated

Atlas PyroVision Hunter Classic Hunter Derby: Open to junior and adult riders that have entered, shown, and completed the course in the adult/junior division. Fences 3’. Each competitor will jump one round over a course of hunter type fences. Open Numerical Scoring System must be used in the first round, with each rider’s score announced at the completion of their round. The 10 horses with the highest scores from the first round, will return, lowest scores first, to jump a second round over a modified course. The average scores of both rounds will determine the overall placing.

Coopers Crossroad Hunter Classic Hunter Derby: Open to junior and adult riders that have entered, shown, and completed the course in the adult/junior division. Fences 2’ 6”. Each competitor will jump one round over a course of hunter type fences. Open Numerical Scoring System must be used in the first round, with each rider’s score announced at the completion of their round. The 10 horses with the highest scores from the first round, will return, lowest scores first, to jump a second round over a modified course. The average scores of both rounds will determine the overall placing. Entries from this class will be donated to Coopers Cross Road.

CoCo Classic Hunter Derby: Open to all riders who did not compete in Atlas PyroVision Hunter Classic or Coopers Crossroad Hunter Classic. Fences 2’3”. Each competitor will jump one round over a course of hunter type fences. Open Numerical Scoring System must be used in the first round, with each rider’s score announced at the completion of their round. The 10 horses with the highest scores from the first round, will return, lowest scores first, to jump a second round over a modified course. The average scores of both rounds will determine the overall place. First Place to receive \$100.
